SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING CALL FOR INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY AT LUCERNE UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES (HSLU) – SWITZERLAND - WHERE THERE IS AN AGREEMENT FINALIZED TO THE RECOGNITION OF THE DOUBLE TITLE YEAR 2026/2027

THE DIRECTOR AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SCHOOL

GIVEN the Statute of the University of Florence and, in particular, article 9;

GIVEN the Academic Regulations of the University and, in particular, articles 11 and 12;

GIVEN the agreement between the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences (HSLU) - Switzerland – aimed at recognizing of double degree for the Master Degree program in Management Engineering (LM-31) signed on 10 June 2023;

WHEREAS the University has as attribution (article 21F of Law 390/91) for the promotion of student exchanges;

REGARDING the "guidelines to be adopted by the educational structures for the recognition of the didactic activities carried out by students in the frame of the Erasmus+ mobility program" approved by the Academic Senate in the session of 3 December 2003 and, in particular, article 10 which provides that these provisions may also apply in the event that student mobility takes place within the framework of any other EU interuniversity mobility program or any international cooperation agreement;

GIVEN the Resolution of the Council of the School of Engineering of October 29th 2025, in which a mandate is given to the Director of the Department of Information Engineering to issue a call for the selection of 10 (ten) students who, regardless of their country of citizenship are enrolled fulltime, in the first year of the Master Degree program in Management Engineering (LM-31) eligible for a mobility period at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences (HSLU) - Switzerland - aimed at the recognition of the double degree for the year 2026-2027;

WHEREAS the Department of Information Engineering is the oversight department for the School of Engineering;

GIVEN the decree of urgency no. n. 13226 (Prot. Nr. 315671) del 05/11/2025 of the Department of Information Engineering related to the issuance of the above mentioned call



DECREES The issuance of the following call:

CALL FOR THE SELECTION OF:

- 10 (TEN) STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE FIRST YEAR OF THE MASTER DEGREE PROGRAM IN MANAGEMENT ENGINEERING (L-31) ELIGIBLE FOR A MOBILITY PERIOD IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 (SEPTEMBER 2026 - SEPTEMBER 2027) AT THE LUCERNE UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES (HSLU) – SWITZERLAND - WHERE THERE IS AN AGREEMENT FINALIZED TO THE RECOGNITION OF THE DOUBLE TITLE

Art.1 Indiction

In order to promote international mobility at Institutions where there are agreements finalized to a double Degree program, the School of Engineering announces a selection for the formation of a list of eligible students for mobility for study and/or internship for 10 (ten) students enrolled at the first year of the Master Degree program in Management Engineering (LM-31) at Lucerne University of Applied Sciences (HSLU) – Switzerland - during the period September 2026 - September 2027.

Art. 2 Purpose of the mobility

The mobility period is aimed at:

- carrying out a period of study and taking the exams at the end of the didactic units attended, furthermore the study period is integrated with an internship period combined to the final Project Work;
- Acquiring 60 ECTS for the recognition of the double Degree as required by the agreement signed on 10/06/2023 with the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences (HSLU) - Switzerland

Art.3 Admission requirements

Students who are regularly enrolled at the expiration date of this call, at the first year of the Master Degree program in Management Engineering (LM-31) can apply for mobility, and are in compliance with university fees according to the procedures established by the University.

Art.4 Procedures and limitation period for applications

In the application, addressed to the President of the School of Engineering, the candidate must declare, under his/her personal responsibility, in accordance with the decree of the President of the Republic n. 445/2000, the following:

- Surname and name
- Date and place of birth
- The possession of the requirements set out in Art. 3
- Indication of contact details and e-mail address
- Self-certification of knowledge of the language

The application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- Self-certification of the list of exams with grades, that the candidate has taken in the Bachelor Degree and relative final grade of graduation



- A motivational letter to the mobility
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of a valid Identity Card/Passport
- Other documents deemed useful by the applicant for the purposes of the selection (for example, certificate of English language proficiency above the required level).
- 2. Applications must be completed according to the appropriate form available on the website of the School of Engineering and sent by post to the President of the School itself Via di Santa Marta, 3 50139 Florence.

The envelope containing the application must bear the words "Application for the selection of 10 places for double degree mobility at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences". Applications must be received **no later than December 12**th, **2025 at 1.00pm**.

The following submission method is also allowed:

The application must be signed and sent scanned together with a photocopy of an identity document of the applicant; in order to submit the application, candidates must be in possession of a personal e-mail address. All documents attached to the e-mail must be in PDF format. The message must include in the subject the words: "Application for the selection of 10 places for double degree mobility at the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences".

Applications received after the deadline indicated above will not be considered admissible and candidates will not be admitted to the selection.

In all cases, failure to sign the application form will result in exclusion from the evaluation

Art. 5 Examining Commission

The Evaluation Commission will be appointed by the Director of the Information Engineering Department under the recommendation of the President of the School of Engineering and will be announced at the deadline of this call on the School of Engineering's website https://www.ingegneria.unifi.it/vp-520-double-degree.html

Art.6 Formation and approval of eligible students

The selection for the formation of eligible students will be carried out on the basis of the following criteria:

- a) Level of knowledge of the English language superior to level B2 or other language certificates up to a maximum of **20 points**;
 - 10 points for a certificate level C2
 - > 8 points for a certificate level C1 or mother tongue
 - > 7 points for a certificate level B2
 - > 4 points for a certificate level B1
 - 2 points for a certificate level A2
 - > 1 point for a certificate level A1

In case of presentation of more certificates of knowledge of the same language, only the certificate with the highest level will be taken into consideration.

b) Profit: calculated on the basis of the Bachelor's degree grade - up to a maximum of **30 points**;



c) Motivation for mobility and congruence between personal, educational and/or work experiences gained and the contents of the study programme - up to a maximum of **50 points**.

The Administration reserves the right to carry out appropriate checks and verifications on the veracity of the self-declarations contained in the application and in the curriculum vitae.

Art. 7 Acceptance of mobility

Eligible students must formalize their acceptance to carry out the mobility before departure and in any case by signing a specific form that will be made available by the offices of the School of Engineering at the following link: https://www.ingegneria.unifi.it/ vp-443-notices-calls.html

Art. 8 Financial support for mobility

- 1. For the mobility financial support, we refer to the "Call for selection of eligible students for Extra-UE International mobility for study 2026-2027", available on the website of the University of Florence at the page https://www.unifi.it/en/university/around-world/erasmus-and-international-mobility
- Grants for mobility are linked to the actual stay at the destination and the recognition of educational credits in the career of the beneficiary student. Financial support does not cover all expenses but it is considered as a contribution to the major expenses related to the stay abroad.
- 3. Contributions for student mobility are related to studies and/or activities carried out abroad. The student will have to return the entire amount of the scholarship received in following cases:
 - a. renounce the mobility period
 - b. do not complete any study activities and do not earn at least 2 credits for each month of mobility (the number of credits registered in the career will be taken into account).
- 4. Students who have been awarded a mobility grant by the Azienda Regionale per il Diritto allo Studio can receive an additional contribution consisting of an all-inclusive sum of money related to the months spent abroad. Art.9 Treatment of personal data
