SEMP MOBILITY 2026/2027

Deadline 9 January 2026 at 1,00 pm

The Swiss-European Mobility Program (SEMP) allows students to spend a period at a Swiss partner university, for one or two semesters.

The SEMP mobility is compatible with the Erasmus+ mobility program provided that the semesters do not overlap.



SEMP MOBILITY CALL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications for mobility may be submitted by students who, regardless of their country of origin, and by the deadline of this call for applications:

- are duly enrolled, or declare their intention to enrol, on a full-time basis for the academic year 2026-2027, or are current with their university fees,
- are in possession of a linguistic certification at least equal to the linguistic knowledge required by the foreign Institution

SEMP MOBILITY CALL PURPOSE OF THE MOBILITY

The mobility period in the frame of SEMP programme is aimed at:

- carrying out a period of study and taking the exam at the end of the didactic units attended (the study period can also be integrated with an internship period, where provided by the didactic regulations);
- preparation of the final project work or part of it on the basis of a work plan approved by the supervisor and the responsible teacher in the host institution (including the quantification of credits earned abroad);

The mobility must be completed by 30 September 2027.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Level of knowledge of the English language or of the language spoken in the country where the mobility takes place up to a maximum of 20 points;
- > 10 points for a certificate level C2
- > 8 points for a certificate level C1 or mother tongue
- > 7 points for a certificate level B2
- 4 points for a certificate level B1
- 2 points for a certificate level A2
- 1 point for a certificate level A1

In case of presentation of more certificates of knowledge of the language, the certificate with the highest level will be taken into consideration.

2. Number of credits acquired at the expiry date of the call (regularity in studies is calculated on the basis of the number of credits relating to exams passed and recorded in the career by the deadline of the call, in relation to the year of enrolment) - up to a maximum of 20 points;

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 3. Weighted average up to a maximum of 30 points
- 4. Study program to be carried out abroad (teaching and exams, courses, internship activities and possible connection with the preparation of a thesis), motivation for mobility and congruence with the contents of the study program up to a maximum of 30 points.

In case of equal scores, priority will be given to the candidate with a minor age.

How to choose exams to take abroad

To facilitate your research, you can download the list of agreements from the School's website, where you will find useful links for choosing courses.

Once you have selected the exams you wish to take abroad, you must obtain equivalence from your UNIFI professor. This form is not necessary for free-choice exams.

If you are interested in an internship/final project work, you must check the Host Institution website to see if there are any internship/final project work projects available for your study course or contact the International Relations Office, which will put you in touch with the responsible of the agreement to ensure that there is a real possibility of doing an internship at your selected Host Institution.

How many locations can you choose?

Each student can apply for a maximum of TWO locations and must draw up a study plan (Learning Agreement) for the first choice
