The Erasmus+ Program was established by the European Union in December 2013 and represents the new EU instrument dedicated to the education sector.

The program is focused on key activities including student individual mobility for learning purposes.

The student mobility is divided into:





# **ERASMUS+ Program (2013-2020) – INFO 1**/2

It is possible to repeat the Erasmus+ mobility more than once during the university career, alternating periods of Study and/or Traineeship, for a maximum of 12 months of mobility for each of the 3 cycles of study (Bachelor, Master and PhD).

# ERASMUS+ Program (2013-2020) - INFO 2/2



Mobility for *Study*: it is based on Bilateral Agreement, within the mobility it is possible to take courses and take advantage of the facilities available at the host institution without additional registration fees.

There is a guarantee of recognition of the study period abroad based on a Learning Agreement to be followed abroad, approved by both the home institution and the host institution.



Mobility for *Traineeship*: it is based on Bilateral or Individual Agreement, there is a guarantee of the recognition of the activity abroad on the basis of a Traineeship Agreement approved by both the home institution and the host institution. Graduate students can also participate.

The participation in both Erasmus+ Studio and Traineeship calls is compatible, in the same academic year, nevertheless the total duration must not exceed 12 months per cycle / level.

Students enrolled at a certain level of education (bachelor, master's or doctorate), in the same academic year can plan a 6-month mobility in Erasmus+ Study (i.e. from September to February) and then 6 months in Erasmus+ Traineeship (i.e. from March to September), or up to max 12 months.

Both mobilities (Study or Traineeship), of the current calls can be carried out from August 2019 until 30 September 2020.

During the mobility for Traineeship is not possible to take any exams!

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ADMISSION

- The students must be enrolled as full-time student at the University of Florence in the academic year 2019-2020.
- Students must be in possession of an adequate knowledge of the required language at the host institution, resulting from a valid certificate.
- Student that do not benefit at the same time of another European Community contribution.
- > Students who intend to carry out a post-graduate traineeship, must submit the application before obtaining the degree.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- 1. Evaluation of the student's career
  - ✓ Regularity in studies: credits earned in relation to the year of enrollment (a maximum of 35 points)
  - ✓ The profit: weighted average increased by 0.25 for each honors awarded normalized on the average mark of the course (a maximum of 35 points).
- 2. Linguistic knowledge

For each declared language, the certificate attesting to the highest knowledge (up to a maximum of 15 points) will be taken into consideration.
